



#### PREAMBLE:

The MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) made on 1st May 2024, between the MTE's Dhondumama Sathe Homoeopathic Medical College's attached Teaching Homoeopathic Hospital Nyaymurti Madhavrao Ranade Memorial Homoepathic Hospital Pune and MTES Sanjeevan Hospital (hereafter as referred to the first party and second party respectively)

Both these institutions are run by Maharashtra Technical Education Society, Pune

#### • SCOPE AND OBJECTIVES OF MoU:

The scope and objectives of MoU are defined as:

DSHMC's Attached Hospital NMRMHH AND SANJEEVAN Hospital agree to sign MOU for the services to be offered by Sanjevaan Hospital's department of Clinical Pathology, Radiology, and Imaging, Physiotherapy, Casualty, ICU, Operation Theatres, CSSD, Ambulance, Blood Bank, Dialysis and any other facilities added here after which shall be utilized for patient care for the benefit of the patients attending the HCO of first party.

In addition to these services for benefit of Patient Care, the first party being a reputed Homoeopathic Educational Institute, the second party shall also contribute to enhance the training of students and staff of first party by sharing academic, clinical training/ Internship, on job training, project work, laboratories, students / faculty exchange and for collaborative research programs to get the mutual benefits.

The MOU will be subjected to discontinuation only by the mutual agreement of both the parties.

#### **DURATION OF MOU**

This MOU comes into effect from the date of its signing and will remain in force for a period of FIVE

YEARS. Its validity can be extended by mutual agreement between both the parties.

#### Specific Role of MTES' SANJEEVAN HOSPITAL:

#### A. Services to be provided to the patients of NMRMHH

#### 1. Department of Clinical Pathology

All the services provided by the second party through department of Clinical Pathology will be made available to the patients / staff / students of first party

Facilities provided by department of Clinical Pathology of second party are broadly as under

- Clinical Bio-chemistry
- Clinical Microbiology and serology
- Clinical Pathology
- Cytopathology
- Hematology
- Histopathology

First party will be responsible to advice the investigations and a written requisition will be submitted properly authenticated by first party for carrying out of the investigations.

All the samples required for Laboratory investigations will be collected at the laboratory collection area of 2<sup>nd</sup> party. Therefore, it will be the responsibility of 1<sup>st</sup> party to guide and assist patients to give the samples required for testing by visiting the lab both for OPD & IPD patients.

Turnover time for the investigations advised shall be 72 hours to maximum 96 hours. However, in case of an emergency it will be informed to the authorized concerned person of first party (MO/HP on duty, referring doctor) on phone immediately. This reporting in the form of verbal reports shall be followed by written reports in such a case and these shall be made available within 24 hours.

List of available investigations and rate list of investigations will be provided by second party to the first party which will be displayed by first party for the benefit of patients. Any changes made in the rate list and list of investigations will be provided to the first party by the second party as soon as it is implemented.

Quality assurance system will be practiced by the first party by periodical Rounds of the department of Clinical Pathology of second party for patient safety. Quality assurance



audit will be done six monthly.

**Billing** 

20% concession will be provided to all the patients / students / staff of first party for all the investigations which are available in the lab of second party. Maximum up to 50 % concession based on case-to-case basis shall be provided by the HCO of the second party for which written permission from head of both the institution is mandatory.

Out sourced investigations shall not get any concession.

#### 2. Radiology and Imaging-

All the services provided by the second party through department of Radiology and Imaging will be made available to the patients / staff / students of first party.

Facilities provided by department of Radiology and Imaging of second party are broadly as under

- 2D Echo
- Holter Monitoring
- Spirometry
- Treadmill
- Ultrasound
- X-ray

First party will be responsible to advice the tests to be conducted and a written requisition will be submitted properly authenticated by first party for carrying out of the tests.

First party will be responsible to guide and assist the patients and give specific instructions as required before sending the patient to the department of radiology and imaging of second party.

Turnover time for the investigations advised shall be 72 hours to maximum 96 hours. However, in case of an emergency it will be informed to the authorized concerned person of first party (MO/HP on duty, referring doctor) on phone immediately. This reporting in the form of verbal reports shall be followed by written reports in such a case and these shall be made available within 24 hours.

List of available imaging investigations and rate list of these investigations and will be provided by second party to the first party which will be displayed by first party for the benefit of patients. Any changes made in the rate list and list of investigations will be provided to the first party by the second party as soon as it is implemented.



#### Billing

20% concession will be provided to all the patients / students / staff of first party for all the investigations which are available in the imaging department of second party. Maximum up to 50 % concession based on case-to-case basis shall be provided by the HCO of the second party for which written permission from head of both the institution is mandatory.

Out sourced investigations shall not get any concession.

#### 3. Physiotherapy

All the services provided by the second party through department of Physiotherapy will be made available to the patients / staff / students of first party.

Facilities provided by department of Physiotherapy of second party are broadly as under

- Work with patients to help them manage pain
- Balance & Mobility
- Motor function
- Manual therapy
- Exercise therapy
- Electrotherapy & sports therapy
- Women's health physiotherapy
- Neurological therapy

First party will be responsible to give a written requisition as per the instructions from treating doctor which will be submitted properly authenticated by first party for carrying out of the Session and Therapy as appropriate.

List of available therapies / services and rate list will be provided by the second party to the first party which will be displayed by first party for the benefit of patients. Any changes made in the Charges and list of Therapies/ sessions will be provided to the first party by the second party as soon as it is implemented.

#### Billing

20% concession will be provided to all the patients / students / staff of first party for all session / therapies which are available in the department of physiotherapy of second party. Maximum up to 50 % concession based on case-to-case basis shall be provided by the HCO of the second party for which written permission from head of both the institution is mandatory.

#### 4. Other Services

Services provided by the department of Casualty, ICU, Operation Theatre, CSSD, Dialysis, Blood bank, Ambulance, and addition of any new services / facilities for the

benefit of patients and enhancing patient care shall be made available to the patients of first party on the same terms and conditions as are made available to the patients of second party

B Provide academic and infrastructural support and facility for the students and staff of D.S. Homoeopathic Medical College and N.M.R.M.H Hospital.

Exchange of information through lectures and practical, relating to their activities in field of mutual interest.

Provide internship to the students. Arrange observer-ship programs for the information periodically and regularly.

#### Common Activities by Both the Parties

1. Both institutions agree to provide work space and technical facilities as applicable

- 2. Both the institutes i.e. DSHMC's Attached NMRMH Hospital and SANTEVAN HOSPITAL, Pune will organize conferences, workshops, seminars etc. The faculty, students and staff shall be encouraged to participate in such activities, so as to interact with each other for their academic and professional growth; such programs will be conducted by both the institutions with information to each other in advance, as and when required.
- 3. DSHMC's Attached NMRMH Hospital and SANJEEVAN HOSPITAL, Pune mutually agree to exchange staff / students for their projects, clinical training/internship, on job training, project work, student/faculty exchange and for collaborative research program to get the Mutual Benefits and without any financial involvement. In case of financial investment and if any the charges will be borne by individual students as per the institute rules and regulations.
- 4. DSHMC's Attached NMRMH Hospital and SANJEEVAN HOSPITAL, Pune mutually agree to help each other to establish and develop collaborative addition of any new department as required by regulatory authorities like Ministry of AYUSH, NCH, MUHS for benefit of patients, research centers, departments. etc. as and when required.
- 5. Both the institutes will participate in relevant government programs / schemes to take mutual benefits of collaborations where ever possible.
- 6. This document is in no way intended to create legal or binding obligations on either party. It serves only as a record of the parties' current intentions to enhance relationship of the Institute and Institute going forward.

#### **General Conditions:**

1. It will be ensured by both parties that the conduct of activities under the MOU will be smooth and achieve the objective of the MOU. The parties may further extend /renew the MOU on terms and

conditions as mutually agreed. The MOU may be terminated only by mutual consent. Once the MoU is

no new activity will be conducted by and between the parties. However, the parties undertake to pursuant/under this MoU.

2. The parties will jointly conduct six monthly/ Biannual meetings to ensure that the activities/programs undertaken under this MoU by and between the parties are conducted in a proper manner and as per the schedule laid down.

#### MISCELLANEOUS

#### a) Assignment

Neither party may assign this agreement or the rights their under without written consent of the other party.

#### b) Entirety.

This Agreement represents the entire agreement and understanding between the parties with respect to its subject matter and supersedes any prior and/or contemporaneous discussions, representations, or agreements, whether written or oral of the parties regarding this subject matter.

#### c) Amendments.

The Amendments or changes to this Agreement must be in writing and signed by duly authorized representatives of both the parties. No amendment or modification of this MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this agreement. The modification/changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made / executed unless otherwise agreed to.

#### d) Independent Entities.

DSHMC's Attached NMRMH Hospital and SANJEEVAN HOSPITAL, Pune are independent parties.

#### Dispute Resolution.

In event of dispute or claim between the parties concerning the interpretation of any provision of this agreement or the performance of any of the terms/obligations of/under this Agreement, such matter or matters in dispute shall be first settled amicably by mutual discussion between the Head of MTE'S DSHMC and its attached NMRWIF Hospital and MTE'S SANJEEVAN HOSPITAL.

The discussion shall be for resolving the dispute arising out of this Agreement. In case if it is not resolved mutually then the decision taken by Chairman, MTES shall be final and mandatory for both parties.

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises the parties have signed the Memorandum of Understanding on 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2024.






