As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-1 Performa were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

- a) On careful examination of the report permission is granted for Dhondumama Sathe (D.S.) Homoeopathic Medical College, F.P.No.23, Off Karve Road, Pune-411 004, Maharashtra for conducting UG (BHMS) course with 100 seats and 12 seats in 04 PG departments namely Materia Medica (03seats), Organon (03 seats), Repertory (03Seats) and Practice of Medicine(03Seats) for the academic year 2022-23. The College has to comply with the full requirements as per NCH Act, 2020 for conducting the course.
2. All admissions in Under Graduate and Post graduate course shall be through NEET/AIAPGET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of UG (BHMS) course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State/UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under.
3. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules. The College has to comply with the full requirements as per NCH Act, 2020 for conducting the course.



4. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under. The category wise list of students admitted may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed.

Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the
National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to
perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act,
2020, following has been stated:

"Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the
educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy
Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be
in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the
rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as
regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under
repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or
taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly
unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act".

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy
has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical
institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents
submitted by your college in Part-I proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and
Rating Board.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has
arrived at the following conclusion:-

That the applicant has set up a Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of
staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has
to take certain time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the



Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course in Homoeopathy.

A. Teaching Faculty:

- i. The College has provided list of 19 guest faculty out of which 06 are eligible. Discrepancies in engagement of teachers are as below:
 - a) Following teachers are not eligible as previous experience not available : Dr. Kedar Ajit Mokashi (Reader, Anatomy), Dr. Deepa S Vyas (Reader, Physiology), Dr. Nirjhara S Wagh (Reader, Pathology), Dr. Shital M Patil (Reader, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology), Dr. Vinay V Kukkarni and Dr Abhijit V Botre (Reader, Practice of Medicine), Dr. Swanand S Gholap, Dr Vijay Madhav and Dr Subhash K Bijlani (Reader, Surgery), Dr. Amol N Muley and Dr. Arun O Mahajan (Reader, Obstetrics/Gynecology), and Dr Jaya Karamchandani (Reader, Community Medicine).
 - b) Dr Akshata R. Nabar (Reader, Pharmacy) is not eligible as previous experience as lecturer is in Anatomy, not Pharmacy.
- ii. The College has provided a list of 11 part time teachers of Modern Medicine but no other documents provided for verification.

B. Teaching Department: There is deficiency in Pharmacy Department as Alcohol License available but not renewed.

C. Miscellaneous: Form 16 -not available and 06 teachers are getting salary less than 10000/month

D. Website: <http://www.mtesdshmc.com/index.html> - website is functional but OPD/IPD Data, list of non-teaching staff and hospital staff not updated.

3 After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to Dhondumama Sathe (D.S.) Homoeopathic Medical College, F.P.No.23, Off Karve Road, Pune - 41004 for 100 seats in undergraduate course (BHMS) and MD (Hom) course in 04 subjects namely Materia Medica, Organon of Medicine, Repertory and Practice of Medicine with 03 seats for the academic session year 2021-22. The College Principal is directed to fulfill the deficiencies, provide documents and submit compliance report within 15 days.

4. All admissions in Under Graduate and Post graduate course shall be through NEET/AIAPGET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

5. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed.



Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

6. The college has to comply with the full requirements of Minimum Standard Requirement Regulations, 2013 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed and mentioned above which affects the performance of the academic Institution, through which College fails to fulfill the statutory requirements, has to be rectified within three months time from issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance as per the HCC (MSR) Regulation, 2013 and will consider admissions for the academic year 2022-23.

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder and Ministry's policy for the academic year 2020-21, In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has examined the documents submitted by the college authority for the admissions for the academic year 2020-21 in 1- BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and and 12 seats in 04 P.G. Dept. namely Materia Medica, Organon, Repertory and Practice of Medicine of Dhondumama Sathe (D.S.) Homoeopathic Medical College, F.P. No. 23, Off Karve Road, Pune-411004, Maharashtra, and furnished recommendation vide its letter No. F. No. 15-8/2020-CCH (Visitation Matter) 3206 dated 15.10.2020 as under:-

"Recommended for allowing admission in 1-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 with the intake capacity of 100 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course and 12 admissions in M.D. (Hom.) course with 03 seats each in the Dept. of Materia Medica, Organon, Repertory and Practice of Medicine.

The Committee also recommended to apprise the Ministry that the website of college is not updated, 04 teachers are getting very less salary and college has not complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations."

2. After considering the provisions of section 12C (I) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, conditional permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Dhondumama Sathe (D.S.) Homoeopathic Medical College, F.P. No. 23, Off Karve Road, Pune-411004, Maharashtra for continuing admissions in BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and 12 seats in 04 P.G. Dept. namely Materia Medica,



Organon, Repertory and Practice of Medicine during the academic year 2020-21, with the condition to fulfil all deficiencies as reflected at para 1 within 31st December, 2020 from date of issue of this letter.

3. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of undergraduate seats and 15 % of Post Graduate of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course and MD(Hom.) course respectively shall be treated as All India quota. The counselling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government vide letter F. No. L. 11011/02/2020-E- (1) dated 26.10.2020 for A.Y. 2020-21 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counselling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.
5. The College shall comply with the provision for providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.



I am directed to refer the provisions prescribed under sub regulation 3(4) of HCC (MSR), 2013, wherein, the existing college has to fulfill the minimum standard requirement of infrastructure, teaching & training facilities by 31.12.2014 for consideration of grant of permission for undertaking admission in the coming academic year. Further, as per the provision of sub regulation 3(9) of HCC (MSR), 2013, if the existing colleges fail to achieve full compliance of the requirements as specified in the regulation by 31.12.2014 the college may be stopped for taking admission in existing Courses.

3. After considering the provisions of HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, inspection report of CCH and policy of the Central Government for granting conditional permission during the session 2018-19, permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to M.T.E.
